3-lined staff: _____ middle of high range
_____ middle of overall range
_____ middle of low range

Any voice (soprano, alto, tenor, or bass) can sing any part.

- represents the beginning or end of a glissando
- represents a sustained pitch (do not glissando)
- ◎ same as above but whistled

Time is somewhat proportional. Vocalists should listen to each other and coordinate their entrances.
